Had Michigan Valley waited to secure materials, we would be looking at June or July before we could hope to deliver. We need to be considering our fall 2022 projects now in addition to provisioning for spring.

For over 35 years Michigan Valley Irrigation has been striving to provide the best irrigation equipment and service available, and we will continue to do so. This means adapting and improvising to overcome unexpected obstacles, creating contingency plans, and expanding our vision on inventory.

What will 2022 bring? We look for reasons to be optimistic about the supply chain and inflation situations improving, however the reality is that we have a six month lead time on new iron, pvc manufacturers are not accepting orders, and prices continue to climb. Our promise to you is to continue to work every day to overcome these obstacles and have you ready for a successful irrigation season.



WHAT IS A PHASE CONVERTER AND WHERE ARE THEY USED?

A phase converter is an electrical device that uses a control panel and a custom electric generator motor to create three phase power from a single-phase source. Phase converters can be used in a variety of locations where three phase power is not available. Typically, you will not see three phase power in rural areas and or residential areas, as it's a commercial power. Phase converters can be used on Pumps, Fans, Pivots, Augers, Blowers, Elevators, Mills, Air Compressors, Wood Working Equipment, Grinders, Welders, and car lifts just to name a few.
